An application to the Ministry of Environment in Cairo

Digging for the raw materials for a health nutritional supplement on the coast line of the Red Sea between Al Quseir and Marsa Alam.

Dr. Matthias Welker, resident in Zugspitzstraße 10 in 85354 Freising, Germany, and Michael Funke, resident in Buchenstraße 5 in 85402 Kranzberg, Germany, would like to develop jointly a health nutritional supplement. The intended product should adsorb toxin and have an anti-inflammatory effect as well as being a preventative for diarrheal disease. The raw materials taken from the Red Sea coast will be mixed with further substances so that an optimal effect will follow.

To begin with we aim to dig 5 tons per year, beginning in autumn 2019. The 5 tons correspond to a volume of around 2.4 m³. With a digging deepness of maximum 1 meter under the current surface.

With a maximum digging deepness of 1 meter under the current surface approximatley 30 cm will be dug up in a length of 20 meters and a width of 40 centimeters ($20 \text{ m} \times 0.4 \text{ m} \times 0.3 \text{ m} = 2.4 \text{ m}^3$). The strip that is caused by the digging will be filled immediately. There will be no changes in the landscape seen.

Immediately after the digging of the mineral mix there will be no biological and genetical change or utilization.

This mineral mix should be turned into a powder in Egypt which will be the basis for the health nutritional supplement. The digging, the classification and the powder process will take place in the Al Quseir region and will create new jobs. Following the expansion of the product range and the product site we hope to create new jobs in the area. Our target for job creation for the next 5 years is as following:

2020: 2 jobs

2021: 5 jobs

2022: 10 jobs

2023: 20 jobs

2024: 50 jobs

Our partner in Egypt is Al Awaldy Consulting & Engineering in 34 Ahmed Said Street, Abbasseya Cairo. Our partner in Germany is dibauco GmbH with its headquarters in Fürholzener Straße 14 Eching, Munich and whose CEO is Michael Funke.

We are filing an application for the regular digging of a mineral mixture of sand and lime with a total amount of 5 tons per year directly from the coast line between the regions of Al Quseir and Marsa Alam.

If necessary we are prepared to found a company in Egypt and with this we would be prepared to rent an exclusive right for mining or prepared to buy the necessary land for this company.




